1. Chaperones will be BUSD approved coaches Jodi Bulis (Girls Cabin), and Anthony Miller (Boys Cabin). We will also work to have additional chaperones if possible.
2. Transportation will be 2 BUSD vans, as arranged through the transportation department, driven by Jodi Bulis, Anthony Miller
3. We will be taking our Varsity Runners. Top 8 girls and Top 8 boys. The roster will be finalized prior to the trip and based on sign-ups and attendance during our summer conditioning program, time trial, and prior performances. Final rosters will be provided prior to the trip.
4. Cost will be covered by fundraising efforts through the BHS Athletic Booster Club.
5. Two cabins have been reserved near each other. 1 cabin for girls and 1 cabin for boys. [REDACTED]

Tentative Itinerary:
